CHARTER DAY

1.12.010 Designated.

The seventh day of January shall be known as Charter Day in commemoration of the anniversary of the signing of the Charter of the Mariana Islands District legislature. (Prior code § 100(1).)

1.12.020 Legal holiday.

Charter Day shall be a legal holiday in the Mariana Islands District. (Prior code § 100(2).)

Chapter 1.16

OFFICIAL FLAG

Sections:

1.16.010 Adopted-Description-Reproduction.

There shall be and there is adopted an official flag for the Mariana Islands District, which shall consist of a white star superimposed on a grey latte stone in the center of the star centered on a field of dark blue seventy-eight inches long and forty inches wide, such star and latte stone to be twenty-four inches high and sixteen inches wide. The district flag may be

reproduced for unofficial purposes in smaller or larger sizes. but in such cases, the dimensions shall be in proportion to these hereinabove provided. (Prior code § 101(1).)

1.16.020 Display.

- A. The flag of the Mariana Islands District shall be displayed in the open only from sunrise until sunset. When displayed on flagstaffs, the flag shall be hoisted briskly and lowered ceremoniously.
- B. When the flag of the Mariana Islands District is flown or displayed together with the flag of Micronesia on separate masts or staffs, it shall be flown or displayed at approximately the same level with that of the Micronesian flag; provided that the flag of the Mariana Islands District shall occupy a position right of the flag of Micronesia, when looking out from the building or platform.
- C. When the flag of the Mariana Islands District is flown or displayed with the flag of Micronesia on a single staff or halyard, the flag of the Mariana Islands District shall be flown or displayed below the flag of Micronesia.
- D. When the flag of the Mariana Islands District is flown or displayed together with the flag of the United States and Micronesia on separate masts or staffs, the three flags shall be flown or displayed at approximately the same level in the following manner of positions; the flag of the United States shall occupy the righthand position; the flag of Micronesia shall occupy the center position; and the flag of the Mariana Islands District shall occupy the lefthand position when looking out from the building or platform.
- E. When the flag of the United States is flown or displayed above or higher than the flag of Micronesia and the flag of the Mariana Islands District, the flag of the Mariana Islands District shall occupy the lefthand position when looking forward from the building or platform.
- F. When the flag of the Mariana Islands District is flown alone at such time as by official order the flag of the United States is being flown at half-mast, the flag of the Mariana Islands District shall also be flown at half-mast.
