§ 2262. Board of Education: Tenure.

(a) Elected members of the board shall serve terms of four years except that the terms of the first members elected shall be determined by drawing of lots with three members serving a term of four years and two members serving a term of two years. Appointed members shall serve for a term of four years, except for a student representative who shall be appointed for the duration of enrollment in a public school.

(b) Elected members of the board shall serve commencing on the second Monday of January in the year following the regular general election at which they were elected.

(c)(1) The Teacher Representative appointed by the Governor shall serve a term of two years.

(2) No teacher may be elected Teacher Representative more than twice.

Commission Comment: The Commission rearranged the sections of [PL 19-07](#) to fit harmoniously within the code pursuant to [1 CMC § 3806\(b\)](#), and accordingly renumbered the sections pursuant to [1 CMC § 3806\(a\)](#); [PL 19-07](#) Section 3, subsections “a.” and “c.” were codified at [1 CMC § 2262\(c\)](#) as subsections (c)(1) and (c)(2) respectively. The Commission capitalized “teacher representative” and “governor” in subsection (c)(1) for the purpose of conformity, pursuant to [1 CMC § 3806\(f\)](#).
