§ 2263. Board of Education: Vacancies.

(a) Any vacancy on the board caused by the death, resignation, or removal of an appointed member shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment to serve the unexpired term of that vacancy. Upon a vacancy on the board caused by the death, resignation, or removal of an elected member, the Governor shall appoint the candidate who received the next highest number of votes in the same election and district where the former board member was elected. If no candidate is interested in filling the vacancy, the Governor shall appoint someone from that senatorial district. Elected members who are employed by the Public School System, shall resign from their employment upon certification that they are a candidate by the Board of Elections.

(b) In the event the appointed Teacher Representative is not able to serve the complete term, or resigns, the Commissioner shall submit the name of the second candidate in the last run-off election to the Governor to appoint as the new Teacher Representative to complete the remaining period of the term.
