§ 2264. Board of Education: Compensation.

Members of the board may receive compensation for meetings actually attended at a rate consistent with Commonwealth law or guidelines. A member who is employed by the Commonwealth Legislature or any of the instrumentalities of the Commonwealth shall receive his or her regular salary under administrative leave status in lieu of compensation for meetings held during working hours. A member traveling on official business shall receive travel and per diem compensation at rates and guidelines established for the Public School System employees. All payments for compensation of travel, and expenses to members of the board shall be paid by warrants signed by the Chairman of the Board of Education.
