**§ 2550. Penalty for Disclosure.**

Disclosure of protected information in violation of this section shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year but not more than two years or by a fine of not more than \$500, or both. The Attorney General shall, to the extent possible, quash any subpoenas or other discovery efforts to obtain any protected information as defined in 1 CMC § 2547 and shall to the extent authorized by law take whatever action is necessary to assure its nondisclosure.
