§ 3703. Commonwealth Recorder's Office: Recording of Documents.

Upon payment of any applicable fees established under 1 CMC § 3402 or any other law, any person may record all documents with the Recorder. The Recorder shall provide public access to and make possible the duplication of all such records.

Upon request, the office of the Attorney General shall render assistance to the Recorder.

Commission Comment: It is unclear to the Commission exactly when the reference to 1 CMC § 3402 was added to the above section. However, subsequent to PL 3-64, PL 6-25 was enacted on May 2, 1989. PL 6-25 embodied the "Judicial Reorganization Act," which created the Supreme and Superior Courts as we presently know them, and thus required an update of Commonwealth Code references to the predecessor courts. As PL 6-25 has been codified, it appears that the proper reference should be to 1 CMC § 3403, instead.
