

TITLE 10: LOCAL LAWS
DIVISION 1: FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT (ROTA)

§ 1103. Slaughter Permit.

It shall be unlawful for any person to slaughter cattle for local consumption or for export without first obtaining a slaughter permit from the resident director of Natural Resources office of the island of Rota. The slaughter permit shall state the applicant's name, address, number and description of cattle to be slaughtered, ownership of the cattle, date of acquisition and type of weapon to be used. If the date of acquisition of the subject cattle is within the past six months, the source of acquisition shall also be indicated.
