

**TITLE 10: LOCAL LAWS**  
**DIVISION 1: FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT (ROTA)**

**§ 1305. Carrying Out of the Uniform Plan.**

Upon approval by the commission of the uniform plan, and the enactment by local law of a local plan, it shall be the duty of the resident director of Public Works to put into effect the plan so approved and they shall thereupon:

(a) Notify the occupants of those buildings and properties for which numbers have been provided by such plan of their respective numbers;

(b) Assign to such new building numbers which have been provided by such plan;

(c) Place on all publicly maintained streets of Rota at intervals established by regulation, uniform streets signs which shall set forth the name of such streets;

(d) Keep in repair all street signs which have been erected and free from all vegetation which may obscure them from view; and

(e) Place and maintain on or near all public buildings of Rota a uniform sign which shall set forth the name of such public buildings, as designated by local or Commonwealth law.
