**DIVISION 1: FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT (ROTA)**

**§ 1501. Short Title.**

This chapter may be known and cited as the Rota Curfew Act of 1991.

**Comment:** Rota LL 7-9 took effect January 27, 1992. According to Rota LL 7-9, § 2:

Section 2. Findings and Purpose. The Second Senatorial Legislative Delegation finds that 1 CMC § 1402 defines setting of curfews as a local matter and therefore, proper to be determined by local laws. The Delegation further finds that the health and welfare of the your of Rota is also a matter of local concern. Further, the Delegation finds that there is presently no existing law for the establishment or the enforcement of curfew hours for minors on Rota, and that the betterment of our community and the protection of our youth requires the establishment of such curfew hours.

It is the purpose of this Act to provide for the establishment and enforcement of curfew hours for minors on the island of Rota.
