

**TITLE 10: LOCAL LAWS**  
**DIVISION 2: SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT (TINIAN, ETC.)**

**§ 2461. Garment Factory Local Task Force; Composition; Duties.**

There shall be established for the Second Senatorial District a Garment Factory Local Task Force (GFLTF).

(a) *Duties.* The GFLTF shall screen and select licensees to operate garment factories in the Second Senatorial District and advise the Tinian joint legislative delegation on legislative changes that are needed for the regulation of garment factories in the Second Senatorial District. Also, after five years from January 23, 1989, the GFLTF shall report to the mayor, the municipal council, and the Tinian joint legislative delegation on whether fewer or more garment factories are desirable for the district.

(b) *Membership.* The GFLTF shall be made up of five members:

- (1) The Commonwealth government customs division employee in charge for Tinian and Aguiguan;
- (2) The resident department head, or his or her designee, of the Tinian office of the Department of Commerce and Labor;
- (3) One person to be selected by the Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan;
- (4) One person to be selected by the Tinian Municipal Council; and
- (5) One person to be selected by the Tinian joint legislative delegation.

(c) *Term of Office.* All members of the GFLTF shall serve terms of two years, with the exception of the resident department head.
