§ 2524. Power of Delegation.

(a) The executive director, with the prior approval of the commission, may, either generally or otherwise as provided by the instrument of delegation, by instrument in writing under his hand, delegate:

(1) To a particular person, or

(2) To the holder of an office, specifying the office but without naming the holder, all or any of his powers or functions under this chapter (other than this power of delegation).

(b) A power or function so delegated may be exercised or performed by the delegate in accordance with the instrument of delegation.

(c) A delegation may be made subject to such conditions or such limitations as to the exercise or performance of any of the powers or functions delegated or as to time, place or circumstances as may be specified in the instrument of delegation.

(d) Subject to prior approval as referred to in subsection (a) of this section, the executive director may make such and so many delegations under this section and to such number of delegates as he considers necessary or desirable.

(e) Any act or thing done or suffered by a delegate while acting in the exercise of a delegation under this section has the same force and effect as if the act or thing had been done or suffered by the executive director.

(f) A delegation under this section does not prevent or prejudice the exercise or performance of a power or function by the executive director.

(g) A delegation under this section is revocable at the will of the executive director and shall be revoked by him if the commission so directs.
