

**TITLE 10: LOCAL LAWS**  
**DIVISION 3: THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT (SAIPAN, ETC.)**

**§ 3114. Saipan Street Directory Commission.**

(a) There is established a Saipan Street Directory Commission which shall consist of the Saipan division consisting of the Mayor of Saipan, the Director of Public Works or his designee, and the Director of Public Safety or their designee.

(b) The division of the commission shall meet regularly to complete and adopt a uniform plan for the naming of public buildings and streets and numbering of buildings and properties. Upon the adoption of such uniform plan, each division shall meet as necessary to revise or add to the plan.

(c) After the commission adopts a uniform plan, the commission shall meet regularly to complete and adopt a local plan for the naming of public streets and numbering of buildings and properties on Saipan. The local plan shall be consistent with the uniform plan adopted by the commission. Upon the adoption of the local plan as a local law, it shall be effective for the island of Saipan.

(d) Members of the commission shall serve without additional compensation.

**Commission Comment:** Executive Order No. 94-3, the “Second Reorganization Plan of 1994” (effective August 23, 1994), reorganized the Commonwealth government executive branch, changing agency names and official titles and effecting numerous other revisions. According to Executive Order 94-3, § 404:

**Section 404. Saipan Street Directory Commission.** The Saipan Street Directory Commission is abolished and its records, property, facilities, equipment, and supplies are transferred to the Office of the Mayor of Saipan.

References to the “Director of Public Safety” and the “Director of Public Works” in 10 CMC § 3114 were also affected by Executive Order 94-3, the full text of which is provided in the Commission comment to 1 CMC § 2001.
