DIVISION 3: THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT (SAIPAN, ETC.)

§ 3117. Carrying Out of the Uniform Plan.

Upon approval by the commission of the uniform plan and the enactment by local law of a local plan, it shall be the duty of the Director of Public Works to put into effect the plan so approved and they shall thereupon:

- (a) Notify the occupants of those buildings and properties for which numbers have been provided by such plan of their respective numbers;
- (b) Assign to such new building numbers which have been provided by such plan;
- (c) Place on all publicly maintained streets of Saipan at intervals established by regulation, uniform street signs which shall set forth the name of such streets;
- (d) Keep in repair all street signs which have been erected and free from all vegetation which may obscure them from view; and
- (e) Place and maintain on or near all public buildings of Saipan a uniform sign which shall set forth the name of such public buildings, as designated by local or Commonwealth law.
