§ 3211. Government Scrap Yard.

The Director of Public Works shall establish the government scrap yard which shall be that area of Lower Base which is south of the public works building and east of the government gas station, or such other area of Lower Base as the director shall deem suitable and appropriate for the purposes of this article. Such area shall be screened by solid fencing by the Department of Public Works by June 18, 1989.

Commission Comment: Saipan LL 6-6 took effect March 20, 1989. According to Saipan LL 6-6, § 1:

Section 1. Purpose. Over the years, many vehicles, pieces of equipment and the like have accumulated on the premises of businesses and residences. This represents an unsightly and dangerous condition which needs to be eliminated. It is therefore the intent and purpose of this Act to eliminate from public view the junk vehicles and other equipment which damage the esthetic values of our Commonwealth.
