

TITLE 10: LOCAL LAWS
DIVISION 3: THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT (SAIPAN, ETC.)

§ 3414. Responsibility.

The Chief of the Division of Environmental Quality of the Department of Public Health and Environmental Services shall:

- (a) Take samples of waters in all public beaches every 48 hours.
- (b) Post permanent signs on all public beaches designated in 10 CMC § 3413 for the purpose of alerting the public of the environmental quality of waters at that location. The signs shall be color-coded: green—safe, yellow—moderate, and red—hazardous.
