

**TITLE 3: HUMAN RESOURCES**  
**DIVISION 1: EDUCATION**

**§ 1103. Principles.**

The public school system, at preschool, elementary and secondary levels, shall be established and organized by law and pursuant to regulations issued by the board or their authorized designees. The board shall establish the philosophy, including goals and guiding principles, under which the Public School System shall be organized. The Commissioner is authorized by the board to implement the philosophy, goals and guiding principles of the board.

**Commission Comment:** Executive Order 94-3, the “Second Reorganization Plan of 1994” (effective August 23, 1994), reorganized the Commonwealth government executive branch, changed agency names and official titles and effected numerous other revisions. According to Executive Order 94-3, § 403:

Section 403. Board of Education. For purposes of administration and coordination, the State Education Advisory Council, the State Interagency Coordinating Council, and the Special Education State Advisory Panel are allocated to the Board of Education, which may assign any of them to the Public School System for such purposes.

The full text of Executive Order 94-3 is set forth in the Commission comment to 1 CMC § 2001.
