

**TITLE 3: HUMAN RESOURCES**  
**DIVISION 1: EDUCATION**

**§ 1133. Student Records: Right to Access.**

(a) Parents or legal guardians of currently enrolled or former students and students who have attained the age of 18 or are attending an institution of post-secondary education have an absolute right to access their student's records related to their public schools.

(b) The board shall adopt procedures for the granting of requests by these persons for copies of their student's records or to inspect and review the student's records during regular school hours; provided, that the requested access shall be granted no later than five days following the date of the request. Procedures shall include the notification of the location of all official student records, if not centrally located. Qualified personnel to interpret records will be made available.
