DIVISION 1: EDUCATION

§ 1175. Nonpublic Elementary and Secondary Education Fund: Established.

There is hereby created for the special purpose of this article, the nonpublic elementary and secondary education fund dedicated to the particular use of purchasing secular educational service consisting of courses solely in the following subjects: English, reading, social studies, music, mathematics, modern foreign languages, physical science, and physical education; provided, however, that as a condition for payment by the Superintendent of Education for secular educational service rendered hereunder, the Superintendent of Education shall establish that:

(a) Solely textbooks and other instruction materials approved by the Department of Education shall have been employed in the instruction rendered;

(b) After five years following October 1, 1978, the secular educational service for which reimbursement is sought was rendered by teachers holding certification approved by the Department of Education as equal to the standards of this Commonwealth for teachers in the public schools; provided, however, that any such service rendered by a teacher, who, on October 1, 1978, was a full-time teacher in a nonpublic school, shall be deemed to meet this condition.
