§ 2133. Regrading After Corrective Action.

The applicant or person in charge of any establishment or premises that received a low grade may at any time make a written request for an inspection for the purpose of regrading the establishment after corrective action has been completed. Upon receipt of a written request, which includes a signed statement from the person in charge that the initial inspection report's corrective actions have been carried out, a Health Inspector will schedule an inspection, for a fee, within ten working days of receipt at the Bureau of Environmental Health office.
