§ 2434. Services; Requirements.

Respite services made available through the Commonwealth Respite Services Program shall:

(a) include a flexible array of respite care options responsive to family and caregiver needs and available before families and caregivers are in a crisis.

(b) be sensitive to the unique needs, strengths, and cultural values of an individual, family, or caregiver.

(c) offer the most efficient access to an array of coordinated respite services that are built on existing community support and services.

(d) be driven by community strengths, needs, and resources.

(e) use a variety of funds and resources, including, but not limited to, legislative appropriation, Council funding, federal grants, CNMI grants, community donations, private and volunteer resources, in-kind, community investments, user fees, and others.
