**§ 4941. Complaints and Actions in Labor Matters.**

(a) *Individual complaints.* Any foreign national worker who is aggrieved by the failure or refusal of his or her employer to comply with an approved employment contract may make a complaint to the Department. Any employer of a foreign national worker who is aggrieved by the failure or refusal of his or her employee to comply with an approved employment contract may make a complaint to the Department.

(b) *Department actions.* The Department may commence an action against an employer or a foreign national worker for an alleged violation of the labor or wage laws of the Commonwealth.

(c) *Court actions.* The Attorney General, at the request of the Secretary, may institute an action in any court of competent jurisdiction for a temporary restraining order, injunction, or other appropriate remedy to enforce any provision of this chapter.
