

TITLE 4: ECONOMIC RESOURCES
DIVISION 1: REVENUE AND TAXATION

§ 1506. Criminal Penalty.

(a) A person commits a criminal offense when he places or causes to be placed into operation an unlicensed poker, pachinko slot or similar amusement machine and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$2,000 or six months imprisonment or both.

(b) A person, including an owner, or operator of a poker, pachinko slot or similar amusement machine, a parent or a legal guardian, commits a criminal offense when he assists, encourages or allows another person who is less than 18 years old to use a poker, pachinko slot or similar amusement machine and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$2,000 or one year imprisonment, or both.

(c) A person, including an owner or operator of a pachinko slot or similar amusement machine, not including poker machines, commits a criminal offense when he places or causes to be placed in operation more than 50 such machines at one location.
