**§ 4202. Authority to Promulgate Rules and Regulations.**

The Registrar of Corporations, with the approval of the Attorney General and the Governor, may prescribe such rules and regulations as are deemed advisable to administer and carry into effect the provisions of this division with respect to associations of persons for any lawful purpose other than for pecuniary profit, cooperatives, and credit unions.
