**§ 4204. Power to Order Production of Records.**

In connection with the duties prescribed in this chapter the Registrar of Corporations may order the production of books of account, papers and documents of any corporation or company authorized to do business within the Commonwealth. Refusal, without a showing of good cause, to produce books of account, papers and documents within 30 days after an order for the production thereof is a misdemeanor punishable by a maximum fine of \$50, or, when the order is directed to an individual, imprisonment for not to exceed 90 days, or both.
