§ 5427. Disposition of Correct and Incorrect Apparatus.

The Governor shall approve for use and seal or mark with appropriate devices such weights and measures as the Governor finds upon inspection and test to be “correct” as defined in 4 CMC § 5423, and shall reject and mark or tag as “rejected” such weights and measures as the Governor finds, upon inspection or test to be “incorrect” as defined in 4 CMC § 5423. Weights and measures that have been rejected may be confiscated and may be destroyed by the Governor if not corrected as required by 4 CMC § 5430, or if used or disposed of contrary to the requirements of 4 CMC § 5430.
