**DIVISION 5: BUSINESS REGULATION**

**§ 5633. Production for Feeding Own Employees Prohibited.**

No business employing more than ten persons shall engage in farming or fishing for the purpose of feeding employees of the business or the employees of any other business unless duly licensed to do so. Any person who violates this section, shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by imprisonment for not more than six months or a fine not to exceed \$2,000, or both, for the first such offense, and imprisonment for not more than one year or a fine not to exceed \$5,000, or both for each succeeding offense. The Secretary of the Department of Commerce may bring a civil action in the Superior Court to enjoin any business from violations of this section.
