DIVISION 10: EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALER

§ 10102. Specific Repealer; Provision for Transition.

(1) The following laws and all other laws and parts of laws inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed:

Title 57, part 1, Trust Territory Code.

Title 71, sections 1 to 8, Trust Territory Code.

(2) Transactions validly entered into before the effective date specified in 5 CMC § 10101 and the rights, duties and interests flowing from them remain valid thereafter and may be terminated, completed, consummated or enforced as required or permitted by any statute or other law amended or repealed by this title as though such repeal or amendment had not occurred.
