DIVISION 10: SPECIAL ACT FOR FIREARMS ENFORCEMENT (SAFE)

§ 10504. Transition – Existing firearm identification cards and dealer licenses.

(a) Any firearm identification card issued pursuant to the Commonwealth Weapons Control Act shall remain valid until its expiration.

(b) Any dealer's license issued pursuant to the Commonwealth Weapons Control Act:

(1) shall remain valid until its expiration. Thereafter, the license may be renewed in accordance with the Second Special Act for Firearms Enforcement;

(2) shall not be subject to [6 CMC §§ 764](#), 767, or 768 until the license expires. Thereafter, the license may be renewed in accordance with the Second Special Act for Firearms Enforcement;

(c) Firearm identification cards and dealer licenses shall continue to be subject to any terms and conditions applicable on the effective date of this Division.
