DIVISION 10: SPECIAL ACT FOR FIREARMS ENFORCEMENT (SAFE)

§ 10508. Transition – Firearms and ammunition ordered prior to the effective date of this Act.

Any firearm or ammunition purchased and in transit to the Commonwealth on the effective date of the Second Special Act for Firearms Enforcement shall be exempt from [6 CMC § 2301](#)(a) and [4 CMC § 1402](#) as amended by the Special Act for Firearms Enforcement. Further, said firearms shall be considered a properly registered firearm under the Second Special Act for Firearms Enforcement if the firearm is registered within 90 days of the effective date of the Second Special Act for Firearms Enforcement.
