§ 10620. Certified abstracts.

Any certified abstract issued by the Department of Public Safety or transmitted electronically by the Department of Public Safety to a court or on request of a law enforcement agency for the record of a named person as to the status of the person's Firearm Owner's Identification Card is prima facie evidence of the facts stated in the certified abstract and if the name appearing in the abstract is the same as that of a person named in an information or warrant, the abstract is prima facie evidence that the person named in the information or warrant is the same person as the person named in the abstract and is admissible for any prosecution under this Division or any other applicable violation of law and may be admitted as proof of any records, notices, or orders recorded on individual Firearm Owner's Identification Card records maintained by the Department of Public Safety.
