DIVISION 2: CONTRABAND OFFENSES

§ 2147. Distribution to Persons Under 18.

(a) Any person who is at least 18 years of age who violates 6 CMC § 2141(a)(1) by distributing a substance listed in Schedules I or II which is a narcotic drug to a person under 18 years of age who is at least three years his or her junior is punishable by a term of imprisonment of up to twice that authorized by 6 CMC § 2141(a)(1), by the fine authorized by that section, or both.

(b) Any person who is at least 18 years of age who violates 6 CMC § 2141(a)(1) by distributing any other controlled substance listed in Schedules I, II, III and IV to a person under 18 years of age who is at least three years his or her junior is punishable by a term of imprisonment of up to twice that authorized in 6 CMC § 2141(b)(2) or (3), by the fine authorized by those subsections, or both.
