§ 3301. Compounding a Crime.

Every person who, having knowledge that a crime has been, is being, or is about to be committed, shall unlawfully, knowingly, and willfully agree for a reward not to prosecute it, is guilty of compounding a crime, and upon conviction thereof may be imprisoned for a period of not more than one year, or fined not more than \$100, or both.
