§ 3325. Unlawful Wearing of Officer's Uniform, Insignia or Badge.

A person commits the offense of unlawful wearing of an officer's uniform, insignia or badge if, not being a sworn police officer, corrections officer or firefighter, the person wears the uniform, badge or insignia of a sworn police officer, corrections officer or firefighter as published in the Commonwealth Register.
