§ 4205. Board of Parole: Duties.

The Board of Parole shall have the power and duty:

- (a) To establish eligibility criteria for parole;
- (b) To conduct parole hearings;
- (c) To establish reasonable conditions of parole and rules and regulations regarding supervision of persons placed on parole;
- (d) To revoke parole if there has been a violation of the conditions of parole by a parolee;
- (e) To enter a final order of discharge when a parolee has performed the conditions of parole.
