§ 6907. Extradition of Persons Not Present in Demanding State at Time of Commission of Crime.

The Governor may also surrender, on demand of the executive authority of any state, any person in the Commonwealth charged in the state, in the manner provided in 6 CMC § 6903, with committing an act in the Commonwealth, or in a third state, intentionally resulting in a crime in the state whose executive authority is making the demand. The provisions of this chapter not otherwise inconsistent shall apply to those cases, even though the accused was not in that state at the time of the commission of the crime, and has not fled therefrom.
