DIVISION 7: HABEAS CORPUS**

§ 7105. Issuance or Denial of Writ.

A judge hearing the application for a writ of habeas corpus and authorized to issue the writ shall, without delay or formality, determine the facts, grant the writ unconditionally, deny the writ, or grant the writ on terms fixed by the court and discharge the person for whose relief the application has been brought or make any order as to disposition that law and justice may require.
