§ 1542. Duties of the Court and Officials of the Commonwealth as Responding State; Prosecution of Case.

(a) After the responding court receives copies of the complaint, certificate, and act from the initiating court, the clerk of courts shall docket the case and notify the Attorney General of this action.

(b) The Attorney General shall prosecute the case diligently. The Attorney General shall take all action necessary under Commonwealth laws to enable the court to obtain jurisdiction over the obligor or the obligor's property and shall request the clerk of courts to set a time and place for a hearing and give notice of it to the obligor in accordance with law.
