**§ 1545. Waiver of Privilege Against Self-Incrimination and Immunity
From Criminal Prosecution.**

If at the hearing the obligor is called for examination as an adverse party and declines to answer upon the ground that his or her testimony may tend to be incriminating, the court may require the obligor to answer, in which event the obligor is immune from criminal prosecution with respect to matters revealed by his or her testimony, except for perjury committed in this testimony.
