

TITLE 8: FAMILY LAW AND PROBATE
DIVISION 1: DOMESTIC RELATIONS

§ 1583. Maximum Amount to be Withheld from Obligor's Income; Priority of Payments on a Single Income Withholding Order.

Withholding of income under this Act shall not be in excess of the maximum amounts permitted under the federal Consumer Credit Protection Act, or fifty percent of the obligor's income, whichever is less. Disposable income shall be applied first to the current support obligation, then to any premium required for employer, labor union, or trade union-related health insurance coverage ordered under the order for support, and then to payments required on past-due support obligations, including delinquencies.
