§ 1587. Termination of Income Withholding Order by Payor.

Whenever the obligor is no longer receiving income from the payor, the payor shall return a copy of the income withholding notice to the obligee or public office and shall provide information for the purpose of enforcing this Act, including the last date of employment and forwarding address of the obligor. If the payor no longer employs the obligor, the income withholding order shall remain in effect for one year after the obligor has left the employment of the payor. If the obligor returns to the payor's employment during the one-year period the payor shall immediately withhold the obligor's income according to the terms of the wage withholding order.
