§ 1623. Request for Court Records of Another State.

If a custody decree has been rendered in another state concerning a child involved in a custody proceeding pending in the Commonwealth Trial Court, the Commonwealth Trial Court upon taking jurisdiction of the case shall request of the court of the other state a certified copy of the transcript of any court records and other documents mentioned in 8 CMC § 1622.
