ROTA LOCAL LAW NO. 13-2
HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 13-028, D.2

A LOCAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT

To appropriate **\$142,000.00 from** the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the First Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE. ROTA LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

Section 1. ~~The purpose~~ of this Act is to appropriate the **\$142,000.00** from the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines for projects and programs in the First Senatorial District as provided herein.

Section 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated **\$142,000.00 from** the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines, pursuant to Rota Local Law 13-1, to be expended for the following projects and programs:

- (a) Dialysis patients subsistence allowance
(\$500.00 per month per patient) and to include arrears **\$25,000.00**
- (b)** Agriculture Fair - Local products competition awards **\$10,000.00**
- (c) Mes Man Amko - Quality of Life celebration
activities/travels **\$ 4,000.00**
- (d) Rota Economic/Tourism Promotional Video
Production **(MVA)** **\$15,000.00**
- (e) Rota Boxing Association **\$ 9,000.00**
- (f)** Jr. Golf Association **\$ 3,000.00**
- (g)** Amateur Rota Golf Association **\$ 5,000.00**
- (h) Rota History Book Publication **(Kolehio Foundation)** **\$ 5,000.00**
- (i) Computer Replacements/books for
Elementary students and Junior Statesman

Program (Kolehio Foundation)	\$21,000.00
(j) Rota Elementary School for Exemplary Teacher awards (minimum 3 awards)	\$ 1,500.00
(k) Rota Jr. High School for Exemplary Teacher awards (minimum 3 awards)	\$ 1,500.00
(l) Rota High School for Exemplary Teacher awards (minimum 3 awards)	\$ 1,500.00
(m) Rota Headstarts for Exemplary Teacher awards (minimum 3 awards)	\$ 1,000.00
(n) Women Helping People Foundation	\$ 9,000.00
(o) Sinapalo DPS Office Rental	\$ 4,000.00
(p) DPW Heavy Equipment Parts	\$10,000.00
(q) Sports and Boy Scouts events/equipment	\$ 4,500.00
(r) Rota Municipal Council	\$12,000.00

Section 3. **Expenditure and Reprogramming Authority.** The expenditure authority for the funds appropriated under Section 2(a), (b), and (c) of this Act, shall be with the Mayor of Rota. The expenditure authority for **funds** appropriated under Section 2(d) of this Act, shall be with the Managing Director. of the Marianas Visitors Authority. For funds appropriated under **Section** 2(e), (f), (g), (h), and (i), the expenditure authority shall be the President of each respective association or foundation. Those funds appropriated under Section **2(j), (k), (l),** and (m), the expenditure authority shall be vested respectively to the Principal of each school. Funds appropriated under Section 2(n), the expenditure authority shall be with the Special Assistant of the Women's **Affairs** Office, Rota. For funds appropriated under Section **2(o)** of this Act, the expenditure authority shall be with the department head of Rota's Department of

Public Safety. Funds appropriated under Section **2(p)** of this Act, the expenditure authority shall be with the department head of the Rota's Department of Public Works. Funds appropriated under Section **2(q)** of this Act, the expenditure authority shall be with the department head of Rota's Department of Community and Cultural **Affairs**. For funds appropriated- under Section 2(r) of this Act, the expenditure authority shall be with the Chairman of the Rota Municipal Council. Any reprogramming of funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act by the expenditure authority, as authorized by this Act, shall be made in consultation with the Chairman of the Rota Legislative Delegation.

Section **4. Repealer Clause.** This Act shall repeal Rota Local Law No. 13-1 in its entirety.

Section 5. **Severability.** If any provision of this Act, or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held **invalid** shall not be **affected** thereby.


Section 6. **Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as **affecting** any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not **affect** any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of this Act **shall** not have the effect of terminating, or in any way **modifying**, any liability civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.


