A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$149,000.00 from the local license fee for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the First Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ROTA LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the \$149,000,00 from
2 the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines for projects and programs
3 in the First Senatorial District as provided herein.

4 Section 2. Appropriations. There is hereby appropriated \$149,000,00 from the local
5 license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines, pursuant to Rota Local Law 11-1,
6 to be expended as follows:

3 The funds appropriated under subsections (a), (b), (c), (d) and (f) of Section 2 shall not
4 be reprogrammed.

5 Section 3. Expenditure Authority. The expenditure authority for the funds
6 appropriated under Section 2(a) shall be the President of the Northern Marianas College. Funds
7 appropriated under Section 2(b), (d) and (e), shall be the Mayor of Rota. For the funds
8 appropriated under Section 2(c), the expenditure authority shall be the President of the Inetnon
9 Manamko of Rota, Inc. Expenditure authority for the funds appropriated under Section 2(f)
10 shall be the President of the Senate with the concurrence of the members of the Rota
11 Legislative Delegation.


12 Section 4. Availability. Funds appropriated under this Act shall be available without
13 fiscal year limitation.

14 Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such
15 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
16 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
17 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

18 Section 6. Saving Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
19 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
20 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained
21 in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The
22 enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any
23 liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes
24 effective.

1 Section 7. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the
2 Governor, or becoming law without such approval.
