HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 16-24, S1

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate One Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand (\$147,000.00) from the local license fees collected for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the First Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE
COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$147,000.00 of the fees
2 collected from the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the First
3 Senatorial District for various public programs in the District.

4 Section 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated the sum of One Hundred
5 Forty-Seven Thousand (\$147,000.00) from the local license fees collected for pachinko slot machines
6 and poker machines in the First Senatorial District as follows:

7 (a) Up to \$2,000 - Reimbursement to medical referral patient Ms. Yvonne H.
8 Manglona for her qualified medical referral expenses in Guam incurred on or about February
9 2009, provided she submits documentation of her qualified expenses allowed under the CNMI
10 Medical Referral Program.

11 (b) \$12,500 - Subsistence assistance to be distributed equally to 13 hemodialysis or
12 terminally ill patients from Rota who are on Saipan for treatment and are provided housing
13 assistance at government expense either in government quarters or hotel/motel.

14 (c) \$17,500 - Subsistence assistance to be distributed equally to five hemodialysis
15 patients from Rota, as named in *Appendix A* which is attached herewith and hereby
16 incorporated as part of this Act, who must temporarily reside on Saipan for medical treatment
17 purposes, but are not provided housing either in government quarters or at a hotel/motel at
18 under contract with the government. The expenditure authority for this appropriation is not

1 authorized to require subsistence recipients to submit any documentation, including receipts,
2 billings, financial forms or any other document in order or as a condition to, or for the purpose
3 of, receiving payment under this section.

4 (d) \$50,000 - For Office of the Mayor for public programs, public sports facilities,
5 and other public projects.

6 (e) \$15,000 - Northern Marianas College student housing for students from Rota
7 attending NMC, Saipan.

8 (f) \$25,000 - Rota Little League for transportation and lodging for upcoming 2009
9 District Little League Tournament in Saipan.

10 (g) \$25,000 - ROMARCA (Rota Non-Profit) Cash on Scale Revolving Fund.

11 Section 3. Expenditure Authority.

12 (a) The Mayor of Rota shall have expenditure authority of the funds appropriated
13 under Sections 2(a), (b), (c), and (d) of this Act.

14 (b) The President of the Northern Marianas College shall have expenditure authority of
15 the funds appropriated under Section 2(e) of this Act.

16 (c) The President of the Rota Little League shall have expenditure authority of the
17 funds appropriated under Section 2(f) of this Act. Not later than 30 days after any expenditure
18 of funds is made the President shall submit a detailed report with copies of supporting
19 documentation, such as but not limited to, receipts, invoices, boarding passes, etc., of the
20 expenditure to the Mayor and the Chairman of the Rota Legislative Delegation.

21 (d) The President of ROMARCA shall have expenditure authority of the funds
22 appropriated under Section 2(g) of this Act. Not later than 30 days after any expenditure of
23 funds is made the President shall submit a detailed report with copies of supporting
24 documentation of the expenditure to the Mayor and the Chairman of the Rota Legislative
25 Delegation.


26 Section 4. Reprogramming Authority; Fiscal Year Limitation. No portion of the funds
27 appropriated under Section 2 of this Act may be reprogrammed for any purpose other than that for which it
28 was appropriated, except by Rota Legislative Delegation Resolution. The funds shall be available for
29 expenditure without fiscal year limitation.

30 Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision
31 to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder
32 of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is
33 held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


1 **Section 6. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed
2 as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any
3 rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any
4 proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect
5 of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in
6 existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

7 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor, or
8 upon its becoming law without such approval.


