A LOCAL BILL FOR AN ACT
FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To name a portion of Route 100 highway in honor of the
late Carlos Songsong Calvo.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE
COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 **Section 1. Findings.** The Rota Legislative Delegation finds that the late Honorable
2 Carlos Songsong Calvo was an accomplished and gifted leader in the Rota community, taking
3 part in many political and civic activities. Amongst his many accomplishments, the late Carlos
4 Songsong Calvo was awarded a Certificate of Meritorious Service by the Catholic Church and
5 served as the Rota District Delegation Representative to the Inter-District Micronesian
6 Conference. The Rota Legislative Delegation further finds that the late Carlos Songsong Calvo
7 was an active conservationist, working hard to preserve and maintain Rota's natural
8 environment. To memorialize the many civic and political accomplishments of the late Carlos
9 Songsong Calvo, the Rota Legislative Delegation finds that a portion of roadway on the island
10 of Rota should be named in his honor.

11 Therefore, it is the purpose of this Act to name a segment of Route 100 as the "Carlos
12 Songsong Calvo Highway" in honor of the late Carlos Songsong Calvo.

13 **Section 2. Street Naming.** In recognition of the late Carlos Songsong Calvo's
14 community service and conservation efforts on the island of Rota, the road from the west
15 corner of Melchor S. Mendiola Plaza heading east along Route 100 to Malilok Point is hereby
16 named the "Carlos Songsong Calvo Highway."

1 **Section 3. Definition.** The Mayor of Rota, in consultation with the family of the late
2 Carlos Songsong Calvo, shall prepare a plan for the dedication within a reasonable timeframe
3 following the ratification of this Act.

4 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or the application of any such
5 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
6 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
7 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.


8 **Section 5. Savings Clause.** This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
9 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
10 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained
11 in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The
12 enactment of this Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any
13 liability civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence at the date this Act becomes
14 effective.

15 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the
16 Governor, or becoming law without such approval.


