HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 18-44, S1

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$40,000.00 from local license fees collected from poker and pachinko slot machines in the First Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE FIRST SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the amount of \$40,000.00 from local license fees for poker and pachinko slot machines collected pursuant to 10 CMC §1901 to activities for the First Senatorial District. The Commonwealth Legislature enacts this legislation under its authority in Article II, sections 1 and 6 of the Constitution of the Northern Mariana Islands. The First Senatorial District Delegation finds that there is a need to provide a subsistence allowance for residents of the First Senatorial District who are undergoing dialysis and treatment for terminal illnesses outside of the First Senatorial District.

Section 2. <u>Appropriations.</u> The amount of \$40,000.00 is appropriated from the local license fees for poker and pachinko slot machines collected pursuant to 10 CMC §1901 for the following purposes:

a) \$24,250.00 to the Department of Finance for the purpose of providing a monthly subsistence allowance for residents for the First Senatorial District who are undergoing dialysis treatment and treatment for terminal illnesses outside

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of the First Senatorial District, as provided under "Attachment A" appended to this Act.

- b) \$1,500.00 to the Rota Municipal Scholarship Fund pursuant to Rota Local Law 17-02.
- c) \$12.250.00 to the Office of the Mayor of Rota to cover airfare costs, ground transportation and other associated expenses for the Rota participants to the 33rd Annual Flame Tree Arts Festival to be held in Saipan from April 25 thru 27, 2014.
- d) \$1,000.00 to the Pacific Islands Bilingual/Bicultural Association (PIBBA) to be held on Rota from June 22 26, 2014.
- e) \$1,000.00 to the Rotary Club of Saipan to assist in the airfare costs for Rota students participating in the *Annual Rock to Read* competition to be held in Saipan on April 12, 2014.
- Section 3. Expenditure Authority. The expenditure authority for subsection (a) shall be the Secretary of Finance; subsection (b) shall be the Chairperson of the Rota Municipal Scholarship Program: subsection (c) shall be the Mayor of Rota; subsection (d) shall be the PIBBA Overall Chairman on Rota; and, subsection (e) shall be the President of the Rotary Club of Saipan.
- **Section 4.** Reprogramming. Notwithstanding any provisions, laws to the contrary, funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other purposes.
- **Section 5.** Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.
- **Section 6.** Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The

enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
