

SAVINGS CLAUSE.** 13 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any 14 existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule, 15 regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect 16 any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not 17 have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which
