HOUSE LOCAL BILL NO. 18-64, D1

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate the additional collections under Saipan Local Law No. 18-07 for activities within the Third Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate the additional collections under Saipan Local Law No. 18-07 for activities within the Third Senatorial District.

Section 2. <u>Appropriations</u>. Notwithstanding any provisions, statutes, laws or regulations to the contrary, the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation hereby appropriates the amount of \$387,000.00 from the additional collections under Saipan Local Law No. 18-07 as follows:

(a) \$60,000.00 for the CNMI Farmer's Cooperative Association for
operations, under the expenditure authority of the President of the CNMI
Farmer's Cooperative Association. The President shall submit an expenditure
of funds report to the Chairman of the Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative
Delegation thirty (30) days after the end of the fiscal year.

(b) \$34,000.00 for the repair and maintenance of the basketball court & social
hall in Precinct II;

(c) \$34,000.00 to construct bus shelters and road bumps in Precinct V;

1	(d) \$34,000.00 to renovate the Health Center in Precinct IV;
2	(e) \$75,000.00 for the construction of Fitme Place road in Navy Hill, Saipan
3	and for the inner road construction from the Garapan Fishing Base north to the
4	Children's Park area by the Carolinian Affairs Office under the expenditure
5	authority of the Secretary of the Department of Public Works.
6	(f) \$32,000.00 for the Office of the Mayor of Saipan for field operations
7	equipment under the expenditure authority of the Mayor of Saipan. The Mayor
8	of Saipan shall submit an expenditure of funds report to the Chairman of the
9	Saipan and Northern Islands Legislative Delegation thirty (30) days after the
10	end of the fiscal year.
11	(g) \$70,000.00 for various projects in Precinct 1;
12	(h) \$30,000.00 for the Public School System to procure school bus(es) under
13	the expenditure authority of the Commissioner of Education. The Commissioner
14	shall submit an expenditure of funds report to the Chairman of the Saipan and
15	Northern Islands Legislative Delegation;
16	(i) \$18,000.00 for the Ayuda Network for personnel under the expenditure
17	authority of the Secretary of Finance. The Secretary of Finance shall submit an
18	expenditure of funds report to the Chairman of the Saipan and Northern Islands
19	Legislative Delegation.
20	Section 3. <u>Reprogramming</u> . Notwithstanding any laws, provisions or regulations to
21	the contrary, funds appropriated under this Act shall not be reprogrammed for any other
22	purpose.
23	Section 4. <u>Severability</u> . If any provision of this Act or the application of any such
24	provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
25	jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
26	circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.
27	Section 5. <u>Savings Clause</u> . This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
28	construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes
29	repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained

in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 6. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or its becoming law without such approval.
