A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$1,081,000.00 from fees collected under Saipan Local Law 11-2;
and for other purpose.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT
TO CHAPTER 4 OF DIVISION 1 OF TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:**

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to supplement the budget of the Saipan and Northern Islands Municipal Council and for the renovation and improvement of the Honorable Pedro P. Nakatsukasa Building, CNMI Street Naming Commission for the naming of Saipan Street, for the CNMI Museum operation cost, for the Mayor of Saipan personnel and operational cost, and to defray the cost of the Saipan Sport Fishermen Association, for the upcoming fishing derby and the tourism promotion.

Section 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated \$1,081,000.00 from fees collected under Saipan Local aw 11-2 for the following:

1. \$600,000.00, for the Street Naming Commission.
2. \$120,000.00, for Saipan and Northern Islands Municipal Council operational cost and for the renovation and improvement of the Honorable Pedro T. Nakatsukasa Building.
3. \$101,000.00, for the Commonwealth Museum operations.
4. \$250,000.00, for the Mayor of Saipan personnel and operational cost.
5. \$10,000.00, to defray the cost of Saipan Sport Fishermen Association on the upcoming fishing derby and tourism promotion.

Section 3. Expenditure Authority. The sum authorized to be appropriated under this Act shall be expended by the Mayor of Saipan for Section 2 (1) and (4), the Chairman of the

Saipan and Northern Islands Municipal Council for Section 2 (2), the Chairman of the Commonwealth Museum for Section 2 (3), and the President of the Saipan Sport Fishermen Association for Section 2 (5).

Section 4. Reprogramming. Section 2, subsection 1 shall not be subject to reprogramming.

Section 5. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or circumstances should be held valid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.
