HOUSE LOCAL BILL No. 16-7, D2

A LOCAL BILL FOR AN ACT

To name the public beach park located near the PIC Hotel in San Antonio (Lot No. 028101) to "Påkpåk Beach Park"; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The Legislature finds that the public beach located
2 near the PIC Hotel in San Antonio (Lot No. 028101) to be commonly known as "Påkpåk Beach
3 Park." The family of the late Ignacio Castro Camacho and Dolores SN. Camacho, who are
4 fondly known as the "Påkpåk" family, have resided at this location for over thirty years and
5 have maintained the beach for the benefit of the community and our visitors. This beach is
6 unofficially referred to as "Påkpåk" beach park and the Legislature finds it fitting and timely
7 that it recognizes the history of the Camacho family's connection to this beach. The
8 Legislature further recognizes the immeasurable contributions of this family in maintaining the
9 beach. Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to officially name this beach "Pakpak Beach Park."

10 Section 2. Public Beach Park Naming. The public beach park located near the PIC
11 Hotel in San Antonio, Saipan (Lot No. 028101), is hereby named "Påkpåk Beach Park." The
12 Division of Parks and Recreation shall install a sign bearing the new name.

13 Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or the application of any such
14 provision to any person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent
15 jurisdiction, the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
16 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

17 Section 4. Savings Clause. This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be
18 construed as affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes

repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or becoming law without such approval.


